Please find attached letter from Julie Jenkins, Calderdale’s Director of Children and Young People’s Services.

I cannot emphasise enough the importance of keeping your child at home/away from school if at all possible.

Any child that can be safely cared for at home should be.

Although we remain open for a small number of key worker and vulnerable children, not as an educational setting but as a safe space with a very skeleton staff, I would like to direct you to the advice from The Educational Secretary on behalf of the Government;

- You should only send your child to school if you have to, because your work is critical to our COVID-19 response
- If you are able to keep your child at home, you should
- #StayHomeSaveLives

Sending your child to school puts your child, you, your family and school staff at risk.

Everyone is safer if they are cared for at home!
